

SAFE LEAVE



A SAFE LEAVE is time taken away from your place of work because you are a victim of family violence or sexual assault so that you can address specific issues arising from those circumstances. They are....

- *for the victim to seek medical care or psychological or other counseling for physical or psychological injury or disability
- *to obtain services from a victim services organization on behalf of the victim
- *to relocate due to family violence or sexual assault
- *to participate in civil or criminal proceedings related to or arising from family violence or sexual assault

How long can you take?

Eligible workers can receive up to 12 days of income replacement in a 12 month period. Your leave can be taken on a continuous basis, intermittent basis or on a reduced schedule basis.

However, if the victim has a serious health condition or needs to care for a family member with a serious health condition because of family violence or sexual assault, they may be eligible for up to 12 weeks of income replacement for MEDICAL LEAVE or CAREGIVER LEAVE.
